### **MAINE CELTICS NOTES**

**HERE WE GO:** The Maine Celtics finished the Showcase Cup portion of the season with the second-best record and will face 7 seed Motor City tonight in the quarterfinal matchup at the NBA G League Winter Showcase. Maine (10-2) is off to its best start through 12 games since the 2014-15 season.

**BIG BOUNCE-BACK:** The Maine Celtics overcame a tough loss by winning the back end of a back-to-back with Long Island Friday night, 111-99 at the Portland Expo. Despite being limited to just 8 players, the Celtics were able to jump out to a fast start, scoring 36 points in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. Maine was led by **Jaysean Paige** who finished with a game-high 29 points. **Chris Clemons**, making his first start of the season, was near a triple-double with 26 points, 12 rebounds and 8 assists in 42 minutes. **Juwan Morgan** added a season high 20 points and 7 boards. **Theo Pinson** contributed 12 points, while **Asante Gist**, who was signed and arrived in Portland hours before the game, scored 11 points including 3-4 from three-point range in his NBA G League debut. The Celtics were playing without Two-Way Players **Sam Hauser** and **Brodric Thomas**, who were in Boston, as well as **Ryan Arcidiacono**, **Deng Adel**, and **Cullen Russo**, who were all injured.

**ROUGH RETURN:** Maine saw its 7-game winning streak snapped Thursday night at the hands of Long Island, a 97-95 overtime thriller. **Brodric Thomas** tied the game in the final seconds of regulation with three of his game high 25 points, but Maine couldn't convert open looks in OT, falling to the Nets. **Sam Hauser** added 15 points off the bench, while **Chris Clemons** contributed 13. Maine turned the ball over 20 times, and was out-rebounded 55-49. Long Island grabbed 22 offensive rebounds, and was led by Josh Gray (24 points) and Brandon Rachal (22 points) both off the bench. Former Maine star **Bryce Brown** added 16 points, including 4 made three-pointers, in his return to the Expo.

**SWEEPING THE 905:** The Maine Celtics led by as many as 42 points, cruising to a 134-106 win over Raptors 905 Saturday. In a game that featured a long delay, the Celtics never cooled off. *Maine set a franchise record by scoring 51 points in the* **2**<sup>nd</sup> **quarter, and tied a franchise record with 24 made three-pointers (24-48).** Seven Celtics finished in double-digits, led by **Brodric Thomas** with 24 points. **Chris Clemons** added 21 points, 7 rebounds, 8 assists and 5 steals off the bench, while Two-Way Player **Sam Hauser** scored 20 points in just 23 minutes on 8-11 shooting.

BEST START EVER: Maine improved to 8-1, the best start through nine games in franchise history, with a convincing 129-103 win over the 905 Thursday night. Despite playing short-handed, the Celtics overcame an early 12-point deficit, scoring 39 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter to surge to a big lead. Maine was led by the bench – Jaysean Paige poured in 31 points to lead all scorers, while Chris Clemons added 20 points and 11 rebounds off the bench. Brodric Thomas paced the starters with 22 points, 6 rebounds and 5 assists, while Luke Kornet made the most of his return to the team (he was playing for Team USA at the FIBA World Cup Qualifying), adding 19 points, 14 rebounds and 4 blocked shots. Theo Pinson scored 14 points while Juwan Morgan added 12 in the win. Maine out-rebounded Raptors 905 57-47, while shooting an impressive 50.6% from the field (44-87). It was head coach Jarell Christian's first ever win over the 905 as a head coach (1-4 all-time).

**SWEEPING THE KNICKS:** After a dominant blowout, the Maine Celtics kept the momentum going, taking down Westchester and sweeping the road series 110-100 on Nov. 29 in Bridgeport, Conn. It was a game that was carried by **Jaysean Paige**, who led the Celtics with 22 ponts off the bench. **Theo Pinson** contributed another solid performance, finishing with 20 points and 8 rebounds. **Brodric Thomas** followed up a career performance with 19 points and 7 rebounds, while **Cullen Russo** added 12 points and 6 boards. Maine out-rebounded Westchester 53-44. Maine used a strong 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, out-scoring the Knicks 31-20, to carry them to victory.

**TWO-HEADED MONSTER:** Celtics Two-Way Player **Brodric Thomas** made his first start on Nov. 27 and did not disappoint. Thomas finished with 32 points, the most by a Celtic this season, on 10-15 shooting. Thomas scored 14 in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter as Maine jumped out to an early lead and never looked back. Thomas added 10 rebounds and 5 assists in the win. Meanwhile, **Theo Pinson** logged another monster performance, finishing with 27 points on 10-19 shooting. **Chris Clemons** added 18 points to pace the bench, while **Sam Hauser** added 14. **Juwan Morgan** finished with a double-double as well, 12 points and 10 boards. Maine shot 56% from the floor (47-84) and 56% from three-point range (20-36).

**BLOWOUT CITY:** Maine completed a sweep of Capital City with a resounding 118-91 win over the Go-Go on Nov. 19. Eight Celtics players finished in double-digits, leading a balanced attack that saw Maine shoot 55% from the field. **Sam Hauser** 

and **Theo Pinson** led Maine with 18 points each. The stifling Celtics defense held Capital City to just 31 points in the first half. *Maine has held an opponent below 40 points in a half three times already this season.* Maine shot 44% (17-39) from three-point range. **Juwan Morgan** scored 15 points, **Luke Kornet** added 12, while **Chris Clemons** scored 11 points off the bench. **Ryan Arcidiacono, Brodric Thomas** and **Jaysean Paige** each scored 10 points in the win.

**CELTICS HANG ON:** It wasn't a pretty game offensively, but the Maine Celtics held off Capital City for a 86-79 win on Nov. 18. Maine's stifling defense held the Go-Go to just 24 points in the second half. **79 points is the lowest total by a Maine opponent in five years.** Maine won despite shooting just 35.9% (28-78) from the field. The Celtics won the game in the 3<sup>rd</sup>, when they scored 33 points. **Sam Hauser** led Maine with 19 points, while **Bruno Fernando** added 13 points and 14 rebounds off the bench. **Theo Pinson** scored 12 points, and **Deng Adel** added 10 in the win.

**LOADED WITH NBA EXPERIENCE:** The Maine Celtics' roster features nine players with NBA experience, the most in franchise history. Point guard **Ryan Arcidiacono** joins Maine with four years of tenure in the NBA, all with the Chicago Bulls. Center **Luke Kornet** suited up for 18 games in Boston last season and has 133 NBA games on his resume. **Deng Adel, Chris Clemons, Juwan Morgan, Theo Pinson** and **Kenny Wooten, Jr.** all have NBA experience as former Two-Way Players. In all, the Maine Celtics players have a combined 551 games of NBA experience.

**CHASING THE SHOWCASE CUP:** The 2021-22 NBA G League season will look different than years past, with two champions crowned. The first 12 games of the season will be played in pods, and the standings will build toward seeding for the Showcase Cup, which will take place at the NBA G League Winter Showcase in Las Vegas. There, the top 8 teams will compete and a champion will be crowned. All other teams will play 2 games at the Showcase. After that, the standings all reset, and a 36-game regular season will be played, starting in late December. Standard NBA G League Playoffs will follow the conclusion of the regular season.

On September 9, the Maine Celtics announced the hiring of Jarell Christian as the 7<sup>th</sup> head coach in franchise history.

Christian, who spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach with the Washington Wizards, is no stranger to the NBA G League. Prior to coaching in Washington, Christian was head coach of the Capital City Go-Go, the Wizards' G League affiliate, for the 2018-19 season. Before that, he was an assistant coach for the Oklahoma City Blue from 2014-18.
