MAINE CELTICS NOTES

CELTICS CUT DOWN NETS: Maine led nearly wire-to-wire, taking down a playoff team in Long Island with a 114-104 win on March 19. **Amari Williams**, on assignment from the Boston Celtics, finished with 20 points and 9 rebounds, while **Kendall Brown** also scored 20 points for his second consecutive 20-point performance. **Hason Ward** finished with a double-double (17 points, 11 rebounds) as Maine went 23-24 from the free throw line for 34 points. The Celtics out-rebounded the Nets 52-33.

WIN SQUANDERED AWAY: Up 11 points at halftime, Maine lost by 16 on March 17th after a second half meltdown in Birmingham, 122-106. The Squadron out-scored the Celtics 74-47 in the second half, including 35-22 in the 4th quarter to turn a three point game into a rout. **Kendall Brown** led Maine with 24 points, while **Keon Johnson** added 20 points off the bench. Three Birmingham players finished with more than 20 points, including Hunter Dickinson who finished with 34 points and 27 rebounds, a franchise record for rebounds in a single game by an opponent. Birmingham shot 53.9% from the field – **Maine has allowed its opponent to shoot over 50% in 20 games this season (3-17)**. Maine was out-rebounded 51-36 in the loss, its second straight.

WILD, WILD SHOOTOUT: Maine took the lead in the final minute, out-scoring Birmingham 45-40 in the 4th quarter, but fell on the road 144-143. **287 combined points is the second highest-scoring game in franchise history, and 144 points is the 7th most in a single game by Maine.** **Keon Johnson** carried Maine with a career-high 43 points on 11-18 shooting, including a perfect 12-12 from the free throw line for 20 points. **Johnson's 43 points is tied for the 8th highest individual scoring game in franchise history. 12 made free throws is the most in a game since Archie Goodwin went 11-11 on March 15, 2019.** **Hason Ward** added a career-high 22 points on 9-10 shooting. **Jalen Bridges** scored 19 points, and **Hank Morgan** had 18 in the loss. The Celtics out-scored the Squadron 82-76 in the second half. Maine shot 57.8% (48-83) from the floor and 21-22 from the line. Birmingham shot 59.1% (52-88) from the field. Both offenses were clicking – there were 61 assists in the game. There were also 55 combined fouls in the contest.

CELTICS CONVERT SHULGA: Two-Way rookie **Max Shulga** has had his contract with the Boston Celtics converted to a standard NBA deal. Shulga joins **Amari Williams** as Two-Way players to get converted to the full roster this season. In 36 games for Maine this season (all starts), Shulga is averaging 15.7 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 6.6 assists per game. A Second Round (57th overall) selection by Boston in the 2025 NBA Draft, Shulga has played in four NBA games this season, and is yet to score in very limited action (1.5 minutes per game).

CELTICS MAKE MOVES: Maine acquired big man **Ebenezer Dowuona** from the Available Player Pool. Dowuona, a rookie, has played in 13 NBA G League games this season between Texas and Oklahoma City. He is expected to be in uniform for tonight's game in Long Island. To make room on the roster for Dowuona, Maine traded **Stefan Todorovic** to Texas in exchange for the Returning Player Rights to **Teafale Lenard Jr.**, who is not expected to immediately join the team. Todorovic played in 35 games for Maine this season, averaging 8.1 points, 2.8 rebounds, and 1.0 assists per game.

TEN-DAY TONJE: The Boston Celtics signed Two-Way guard **John Tonje** to a 10-day contract on Feb. 19. Tonje, who was recently acquired from the Utah Jazz, has played in two games for Maine, and is averaging 18.5 points per game this season in the NBA G League.

TATUM ASSIGNED TO MAINE: Boston Celtics star **Jayson Tatum** was assigned to the Maine Celtics for practice on Feb. 9 at the Auerbach Center in Boston. Tatum, along with **Hugo Gonzalez**, were assigned and immediately recalled after practice. This was Tatum's first career assignment to the NBA G League.

EVBUOMWAN EARNS CALL-UP: **Tosan Evbuomwan** has become the second Maine Celtics player to earn a GATORADE Call-Up to the NBA this season, signing a Two-Way contract with the Charlotte Hornets on Feb. 6. Evbuomwan is the 25th Maine player all-time to earn a call-up. Evbuomwan joined Maine on Jan. 14. In nine games with the Celtics, he averaged 19.4 points, 5.9 rebounds, and 4.7 assists in 35.2 minutes per game. He recorded three double-doubles for Maine, including a 34 point-10 assist performance on Jan. 25 vs. Greensboro. Evbuomwan started the season on a Two-Way with the New York Knicks. He has played in 50 career NBA games.

CELTICS CONVERT WILLIAMS: Big man **Amari Williams** is no longer on a Two-Way contract. The Boston Celtics announced on Feb. 5 that the team has signed the rookie to a multi-year contract. Williams has played in 21 games for Maine this season, averaging 15.1 points, 11.4 rebounds, 5.0 assists, and 1.8 blocks per game. Williams has recorded two triple-doubles and 10 double-doubles with Maine this season. In Boston, Williams has appeared in 13 games, averaging 1.7 points and 2.1 rebounds in 8.2 minutes per game.

BOSTON ADDS TONJE AT DEADLINE: The Boston Celtics were very active at the NBA trade deadline. In one of four trades, the Celtics acquired Two-Way player **John Tonje** and a future 2nd Rounder from the Utah Jazz in exchange for Chris Boucher. Tonje has played in 32 G League games for Salt Lake City this season, averaging 18.0 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.4 assists, and 1.0 steals. Tonje was selected by the Jazz with the 53rd overall pick in the 2025 NBA Draft after five collegiate seasons. Tonje scored 27 points and grabbed 12 rebounds for Salt Lake City in their game at Maine on Jan. 9.

NINE IN A ROW! The Maine Celtics were under a franchise record nine-game winning streak after the Dec. 10 come-from-behind win at Capital City, 112-101. Down by as many as 11 in the first half, Maine roared back in the 3rd quarter, ending the period on a 26-2 run to take the lead and cruise to victory. The Celtics out-scored the Go-Go 34-16 in the 3rd, making 6 three-pointers. **Max Shulga** led the Celtics with a career-high 25 points, while **Keon Johnson** contributed a strong second half to finish with 21 points, 9 rebounds, and 6 assists. **Hason Ward** and **Stefan Todorovic** each scored 14 in the win, while **Aaron Scott** added 10 points off the bench. Maine out-rebounded Capital City 49-32 and won the game despite forcing only 8 Go-Go turnovers.

CELTICS ADD NBA VET: Maine acquired guard **Keon Johnson** off of waivers on Dec. 1. The 21st overall pick in the 2021 NBA Draft, Johnson has played in 161 career NBA games, including 79 for Brooklyn last season. He averaged 10.6 points per game for the Nets in 2024-25. Johnson has also played in 57 G League games in his career, 41 of those with Long Island in 2023-24.

HARPER JR. NAMED POW: Maine Celtics Two-Way guard **Ron Harper Jr.** was named NBA G League Player of the Week for games played Nov. 17-23. Harper led Maine to a perfect record in the week, averaging 36.0 points per game. He threw in a career-high 46 points in the Nov. 21 win over Delaware, the fifth most in a single game in franchise history.

ASSISTS ASSIST BIG COMEBACK: The Maine Celtics dished out a **Franchise Record 43 assists** in Maine's come-from-behind 129-119 win over Delaware on Nov. 23. The Celtics trailed by as many as 23 points in the first half before roaring back.

THAT WAS FAST: The Maine Celtics have their first GATORADE Call-Up to the NBA of the season. **Wendell Moore Jr.** signed a Two-Way contract with the Detroit Pistons on Nov. 10. Moore averaged 21.5 points over Maine's first two games of the season, including a career-best 28 point performance on Nov. 7. The NBA veteran has played 90 games in his career for Minnesota, Charlotte, and Detroit. Last season, two Maine Celtics earned call-ups – **Ron Harper Jr.** (Two-Way, Detroit) and **Phillip Wheeler** (10-day, Philadelphia).

PRESSEY MAKES DEBUT: Maine Celtics new head coach **Phil Pressey** made his head coaching debut Nov. 7 at Greensboro. Pressey, who served as a player development coach in Boston last season, was named 11th head coach in Maine franchise history this fall, replacing **Tyler Lashbrook**, who left to accept a full-time assistant coach position with the Boston Celtics. **Pressey is the first Maine head coach who also played for the franchise** – the former point guard played one game for the then-Maine Red Claws during the 2014-15 season, scoring 34 points. Former Maine head coach **Jarell Christian** remains general manager of Maine for a fourth season.

NEW-LOOK CELTICS: Only three players are back with the Maine Celtics from last year's squad. Two-Way guard **Ron Harper, Jr.** is back with Maine after playing 14 games for the Celtics last season, averaging 17.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 2.7 assists per game. Harper earned a GATORADE Call-Up, signing a Two-Way Contract with the Detroit Pistons. Forward **Hason Ward** returns for a second season – in his rookie campaign, Ward was the only player to play in all 50 games in 2024-25. And **Kameron Warrens** returns to the Celtics for 2025-26 – the guard played 21 games for Maine last season.

REPLACING THE MVP: For the first time since the 2021-22 season, the Maine Celtics are without **JD Davison**. The point guard played three seasons for Maine, all on a Two-Way Contract. Davison was named NBA G League MVP last season,

averaging 25.6 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 7.8 assists per game. Davison finished his time in Maine as the franchise leader in almost every statistical category, including points (2,677), assists (1,065), steals (159), field goals (994), minutes (4,475), and games played (133). He is also the franchise playoff leader in most categories. Davison finished last season on a full contract with Boston. He was waived in the off-season and is currently on a Two-Way Contract with the Houston Rockets.

Head Coach - Phil Pressey

On July 2, 2025, **Phil Pressey** made history, accepting the role of Head Coach for the 2025-26 NBA G League season. Pressey becomes the first head coach in franchise history to also play for Maine during his career. The former NBA guard played at the Portland Expo while on assignment from the Boston Celtics during the 2014-15 season.

“I’d like to thank Brad Stevens, Joe Mazzulla, and the entire Celtics organization for believing in me and giving me a chance to grow, lead, and develop,” said Pressey. “I’m grateful for the opportunity and I will give my all to this team. The community of Portland is amazing, and I remember my time as a player was unforgettable at the Expo. My goal is to instill winning habits into every player who suits up for the Maine Celtics.”

Pressey began his coaching career in 2022 as an assistant coach with his alma mater, the University of Missouri. He then joined the Boston Celtics in 2023 where he has been ever since, working as a Player Development coach.

A three-year standout at Missouri, Pressey played in 148 career NBA games over three seasons, 125 of those with the Celtics from 2013-15. In that time, he averaged 3.1 points, 1.9 rebounds, and 2.9 assists per game. Additionally, he played in 78 career G League games from 2014-17.

“Phil is a dedicated coach who has been instrumental in our player development over the last two seasons,” said Boston Celtics Head Coach **Joe Mazzulla**. “I am looking forward to seeing him grow as a coach and leader. He shows great energy and a willingness to learn. His personality and communication will be a gift to his players.”

“We’re excited to welcome Phil to the Maine Celtics as our new head coach,” said Maine Celtics General Manager **Jarell Christian**. “Phil’s journey – from playing in the NBA and NBA G League to developing talent with the Boston Celtics – makes him the perfect fit to lead our team and connect with the Maine community. We can’t wait for our fans to get to know him and see the energy and passion he brings to the game.” Pressey is the son of former NBA player **Paul Pressey**, who also was an assistant coach for seven NBA teams from 1992-2016.

MAINE CELTICS

Ron Harper Jr.

Guard – 6'5 – 233 pounds – Age: 25 – Two-Way Player – College: Rutgers

Ron Harper Jr. signed a Two-Way Contract with the Boston Celtics on October 16, 2025. Harper Jr. appeared in three preseason games with the Celtics, averaging 4.3 points, 0.7 rebounds and 1.0 assists in 10.6 minutes per game. Harper Jr. shot 40.0% from the field, including 42.9% from three. The 25-year-old guard will embark on his fourth season in the NBA, most recently playing for the Detroit Pistons on a Two-Way Contract. He appeared in one game for the Pistons last season, recording four points, seven rebounds, and two assists in 17 minutes of work. Harper Jr. has appeared in 11 NBA games total during his career, averaging 2.2 points, 1.3 rebounds, and 0.6 assists. Prior to signing with the Pistons, Harper Jr. played 14 games with the Maine Celtics during the 2024-25 NBA G League season. He averaged 14.1 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 24.6 minutes per contest in a Maine uniform. When Harper Jr. inked a deal with Detroit, he became the 22nd NBA Call-Up in franchise history. Prior to his time in Detroit and Portland, the New Jersey native spent two seasons with the Toronto Raptors organization as a Two-Way player. Harper Jr. is the son of Ron Harper, a five-time NBA champion. His brother, Dylan Harper, was selected with the second overall pick in the 2025 NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

Max Shulga

Guard – 6'4 – 210 pounds – Age: 23 – Two-Way Player – College: VCU

Max Shulga was drafted by the Boston Celtics with the 57th overall pick in the 2025 NBA Draft. The rookie guard appeared in three preseason games with Boston, averaging 1.3 points, 1.0 rebounds and 0.7 assists in 3.1 minutes per game. Shulga played five Summer League contests for the Celtics, posting 5.0 points, 1.6 rebounds, and 3.8 assists in 21.0 minutes per game. Shulga also averaged 1.8 steals per game during Summer League. Shulga played his first three collegiate seasons at Utah State University, where he was teammates with current Boston Celtics center Neemias Queta. He played his final two collegiate seasons at Virginia Commonwealth, where Shulga was named the Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Year after averaging 15.0 points, 5.9 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.8 steals per game during his

senior campaign. Born in Kiev, Ukraine, Shulga is the eighth Ukrainian to be drafted to the NBA and is the third Celtic, joining Svi Mykhailiuk and Vitaly Potapenko.

Amari Williams

Center – 6'11 – 250 pounds – Age: 23 – Two-Way Player – College: Kentucky

Amari Williams was selected by the Boston Celtics with the 46th overall pick in the 2025 NBA Draft. The rookie appeared in three preseason games with Boston, averaging 2.0 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 0.7 assists in 5.3 minutes per game. Williams played in four Summer League contests, averaging 6.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.8 assists in 17.6 minutes per game. Williams spent his first four collegiate seasons at Drexel University, where he became the first player in CAA history to win three conference Defensive Player of the Year Awards. Williams concluded his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, where the forward averaged 10.9 points, 8.5 rebounds and 3.2 assists on 56% shooting from the field. Defensively, he averaged 1.2 blocks per game for the Wildcats. Williams is the first British-born player in Celtics history.

Pedro Bradshaw

Forward - 6'7 - 180 pounds - Age: 27 - College: Bellarmine

How Acquired: Trade

On January 2, 2026, the Maine Celtics acquired Pedro Bradshaw in a trade with the Salt Lake City Stars. Bradshaw brings over 125 games of NBA G League experience to the Celtics. He played overseas in both Australia and Germany last season, averaging 10.6 points and 5.4 rebounds in 26.9 minutes per game. In his last G League season, Bradshaw played 45 games for the Indiana Mad Ants in 2023-24, averaging 8.6 points, 6.2 rebounds, and 1.7 assists per game. Bradshaw has now played on four G League teams and has surpassed 20 points in a G League game six times in his career. During his college days at Bellarmine University, the 6'7 forward averaged 15.9 points, 6.9 rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game, earning Atlantic Sun First Team All-Conference honors during his junior season in 2021.

Jalen Bridges

Forward – 6'8 – 225 pounds – Age: 24 – College: Baylor

How Acquired: Affiliate Player

Jalen Bridges begins his second season in the NBA G League and first with the Maine Celtics. Bridges played three preseason games with Boston, averaging 2.3 points, 1.3 rebounds and 0.7 assists in 7.5 minutes per game. He played four games with the Celtics in the 2025 NBA Summer League, tallying 8.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 1.5 steals in 15.5 minutes per game. After going undrafted in 2024, Bridges signed a Two-Way contract with the Phoenix Suns. Bridges appeared in eight regular season games with the Suns during his rookie season, averaging 1.1 points in 3.8 minutes per game. In the NBA G League, Bridges tallied 14.3 points, 5.7 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 1.3 steals in 31 games with the Valley Suns. Bridges played two seasons at West Virginia before concluding his collegiate career with two more seasons at Baylor. Bridges was an All-Big 12 Third Team selection after posting career highs of 12.2 points, 5.7 rebounds, 1.4 assists and 1.1 steals per game during his senior season.

Kendall Brown

Guard – 6'8 – 205 pounds – Age: 22 – College: Baylor

How Acquired: Returning Player Rights

Kendall Brown begins his fourth professional season and first campaign with the Maine Celtics. Brown brings NBA experience to Maine, including his time spent with Boston during the 2025 preseason. Brown averaged 2.3 points, 1.0 rebounds and 0.7 assists in 5.1 minutes per game with the Celtics. During the 2025 NBA Summer League, Brown posted 8.6 points, 1.8 rebounds and 1.0 assists in 15.0 minutes per game with Boston. Last season, Brown averaged 16.1 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.9 assists with the NBA G League's Long Island Nets. He agreed to a Two-Way deal with the Brooklyn Nets in February and finished the season splitting time between Long Island and Brooklyn. Drafted out of Baylor with the 48th overall pick in the 2022 NBA Draft by the Minnesota Timberwolves, Brown's rights were acquired by the Indiana Pacers. He spent two seasons with Indiana on a Two-Way contract, appearing in 21 total NBA games. In March 2024, Brown signed a standard NBA deal with Indiana. In his one collegiate season at Baylor, Brown was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman team after averaging 9.7 points and 4.9 rebounds per game.

Ebenezer Dowuona

Center - 6'11 - 230 pounds - Age: 23 - College: James Madison

Ebenezer Dowuona was acquired from the Available Player Pool by the Maine Celtics on February 24. He has played in 13 NBA G League contests during his rookie season for the Texas Legends and Oklahoma City Blue. Dowuona has averaged 2.3 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 1.2 blocks per game in limited minutes. Originally from Ghana, Dowuona began his collegiate career at NC State. After three seasons with the Wolfpack, he transferred to Georgia Tech, where Dowuona played one season. The big man finished his collegiate career at James Madison where he led the Dukes with 24 blocks and averaged 2.0 points and 2.2 rebounds in 11.5 minutes per game.

Hayden Gray

Guard – 6'4 – 190 pounds – Age: 22 – College: UC San Diego

How Acquired: Affiliate Player

Hayden Gray joins the Maine Celtics for his rookie season. Gray competed in two games with the Boston Celtics during the 2025 NBA Summer League. Gray averaged 3.5 points, 1.0 rebounds, 1.0 assists, and 1.0 steals in 11.0 minutes per game. Gray's collegiate career began at Azusa Pacific for two seasons before he transferred to UC San Diego. In his final season with the Tritons, Gray averaged 11.2 points, 3.1 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 3.1 steals per game while shooting 41.8% from three. Gray was named the Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year and led NCAA Division I in steals per game.

Keon Johnson

Guard – 6'5 – 185 pounds – Age: 23 – College: Tennessee

How Acquired: Available Player Pool

Keon Johnson brings 161 games of NBA experience to the Maine Celtics. Johnson started in 56 of the 79 games he appeared in for the Brooklyn Nets during the 2024-25 season. The veteran guard led Brooklyn in steals (82), was second in minutes played (1,925), and third in assists (175). Overall, Johnson posted career high averages of 10.6 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game last season. Johnson scored a career-high 25 points twice last season on December 27 against San Antonio and on February 5 against Washington. Johnson appeared in five games with Brooklyn in 2023-24 while on a Two-Way contract. The 6'5 guard appeared in 40 games for the Trail Blazers in 2022-23 where he averaged 4.7 points, 1.1 rebounds, and 1.5 assists in 10.4 minutes per game. Later that season, Johnson signed with the Brooklyn Nets. He played for the Nets on a Two-Way contract in 2023-24, where he appeared in five NBA games. Johnson appeared in 41 G League games with the Long Island Nets that season, averaging 17.7 points, 5.7 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.1 steals per game on 47.1% shooting from the field. After earning SEC All-Freshman honors during his one season at Tennessee, Johnson was selected with the 21st overall pick in the 2021 NBA Draft by the New York Knicks and was traded to the Los Angeles Clippers via a draft day trade. He holds the NBA Draft Combine Record for the highest max vertical leap at 48 inches.

Aaron Scott

Guard - 6'7 - 200 pounds – Age: 22 – College: St. John's

How Acquired: Affiliate Player

Aaron Scott joins the Maine Celtics for his rookie season. Scott competed with the Boston Celtics during training camp and the 2025 NBA Summer League. Scott played in two Summer League contests with the Celtics, averaging 1.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists in 11.8 minutes per game. Scott played a key role in St. John's winning their first outright Big East title since 1985. In his final collegiate season, he averaged 8.4 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.4 steals in 36 games with the Red Storm. Scott played his first three collegiate seasons at North Texas, where he helped the Mean Green win the NIT Championship in 2023.

Hason Ward

Forward – 6'9 – 230 pounds – Age: 25 – College: Iowa State

How Acquired: Returning Player Rights

Hason Ward returns to Maine for his second season with the Celtics. He competed in 2025 NBA Summer League with Oklahoma City, averaging 5.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game on 65% shooting from the field. During his rookie season in 2024-25, Ward was the only Maine Celtics player to appear in all 50 games. Ward averaged 7.8 points, 6.4 rebounds and 1.2 assists on 66% shooting from the floor in 21.9 minutes per game. Defensively, Ward recorded 2.2 blocks per contest, which ranked inside the top 10 among G League rim defenders. He played three collegiate seasons at Virginia Commonwealth and was named to the Atlantic 10 All-Defensive team in 2021. Ward played his final two

collegiate seasons at Iowa State. He averaged 6.0 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.2 blocks per game in his final season, leading the Cyclones to an NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2024. Ward was born in St. Thomas, Barbados and was a high school basketball standout at Springfield Central in Springfield, Massachusetts.

Kameron Warrens

Guard – 6'5 – 205 pounds – Age: 25 – College: University of Mary

How Acquired: Returning Player Rights

Kameron Warrens is back in green after appearing in 22 total games for the Maine Celtics during his rookie season in 2024-25. Warrens averaged 4.2 points and 2.1 rebounds in 14.3 minutes per game last season. The second-year guard lit up the Portland Expo on February 13, 2025, when Warrens scored 17 of his career-high 19 points in the third quarter to lead Maine to a thrilling victory over Long Island. Warrens has previously played professionally in the Georgia-A League, appearing in 14 games for VSA in Georgia. Warrens was a three-year standout at the University of Mary in North Dakota. He started all 26 games his senior season, averaging 12.8 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game. Warrens began his collegiate career at Yuba College for two seasons.


