<b>Terrell Brown Jr.</b>	Acquired via returning player rights after joining Swarm during the 2025 season.
<b>Trevon Duval</b>	Acquired via the NBA G League available player pool on March 9, 2026.
<b>Tosan Evbuomwan</b>	Signed a two-way deal with the Charlotte Hornets on Feb. 6, 2026.
<b>Marcus Garrett</b>	Acquired via returning player rights after joining Swarm during the 2023-24 season.
<b>Evan Gilyard II</b>	Acquired via trade on Feb. 10, 2026, in exchange for forward Eric Dixon. The returning player rights to center Armando Bacot were also included in the deal.

**SWARM LEADS LEAGUE IN UNIQUE STARTING LINEUPS**

Continuity has been key for the Greensboro Swarm in 2025-26, and with consistency in style between the Charlotte Hornets and Swarm, constant movement has actually been an advantage.

**This season, the Swarm lead the NBA G League in unique starting lineups (37), including unique starting lineups every game of the NBA G League Playoffs.**

The Swarm have battled multiple roster and injury changes this season, including the departure of two-way guard KJ Simpson (NBA waivers), Keyontae Johnson (buyout; CBA) and the loss of PJ Hall, who suffered a right ankle fracture in the first round of the NBA G League Playoffs.

Despite this, the Swarm has rallied around NBA assignments Liam McNeeley and Tidjane Salaun while leaning into its core set of returners Jaylen Sims, Terrell Brown Jr. and Marcus Garrett.

**SWARM POSTED SECOND-HIGHEST PPG IN G LEAGUE HISTORY**

The Greensboro Swarm rewrote its record book in 2025-26, record all five of the team's highest scoring games.

With that, the Swarm posted the second-highest PPG in a season in NBA G League history, trailing only the 2014-15 Reno Bighorns, the then affiliate of the Sacramento Kings.

## TRAINING CAMP STANDOUTS REPLACE PJ HALL

The Greensboro Swarm lost PJ Hall to a season-ending right ankle fracture in the fourth quarter of the team's first-round game against the Maine Celtics.

In his place, center **Jonas Aidoo** made his first two career NBA G League starts in the Eastern Conference Semifinals and Finals. Aidoo opened the showing with six blocks against the Go-Go, **tying the franchise's third-most blocks in a game** and marking the first time since Nov. 18, 2023, a Swarm player has hit six blocks. The last player to do so was Nathan Mensah vs. Raptors 905.

Aidoo joined the Swarm via an Exhibit-10 contract signed with the Charlotte Hornets in preseason. However, due to injury, Aidoo was the final member waived from the Swarm's preseason roster, joining the team once healthy in December.

In his place, **Josiah Allick**, the NBLNZ (New Zealand) MVP a season ago, earned the final roster spot on the team, developing into a key rotational piece and fan favorite in Greensboro.

Allick, 24, logged two critical tip-ins during the fourth quarter of the Eastern Conference Finals -- stopping the Osceola Magic's biggest comeback of the game that saw it trim the Swarm's lead to 115-111.

Outside of his knack for flying for loose balls, Allick has also become a fan favorite for courtside fans, as after every timeout, he will high five each fan on the home side of the bench -- and will also do so with every coach, regardless of score.

## GREENSBORO SWARM CHESS CLUB

The Greensboro Swarm's bond has gone beyond the court as the team routinely finds time to meet for dinner and engage in activities outside of basketball.

In recent weeks, the team has honed its IQ off the court with the Greensboro Swarm Chess Club. While most games are played virtually in the locker room, the extracurricular has helped the team find its competitive edge on and off the court.

As of now, Jaire Grayer leads the pack of Swarm chess players, with Tosan Evbuomwan and Liam McNeeley not too far behind.

"It's a lot of little things [that set this team apart from previous seasons]," said Terrell Brown Jr. "We spend time together -- going out to eat on the road, hanging out, even here in Greensboro. The team sets up meals, we'll go watch games together, especially during March Madness. And we actually started a little chess tournament -- like an online competition in the locker room. Everybody's playing right now. It's been fun, but it also keeps us competitive and sharp mentally.

"Right now, Jaire is probably the best chess player in the locker room. Tosan's getting back into it, and Liam too."

## 91-YEAR-OLD SWARM STAFFER HAS NEVER MISSED HOME GAME

Friday marked a monumental moment for the Greensboro Swarm, who had not won an NBA G League Playoff game prior to this season and have now secured their first postseason victory in franchise history.

Throughout the organization's 10-year existence, 91-year-old Paul Brown has been a constant inside Novant Health Fieldhouse. Serving as the team's stat runner since the inaugural 2016 season, Brown has worked every home game in franchise history, delivering box scores during stoppages in play.

Due to mobility, Brown now delivers stats exclusively to the home bench, but his presence remains a staple of the Swarm game-day operation -- a decade-long symbol of consistency and commitment behind the scenes.

**He won PGA Volunteer of the Year in 2019** -- being selected from a pool of 100,000 volunteers across 36 tournaments. He began as a spotter on No. 16 at Forest Oaks before taking over a par-3 assignment, later working holes No. 15 and 16 following the tournament's move to Sedgefield. Brown now serves as a hole captain on No. 2, continuing a volunteer career defined by consistency and dedication.

## A HISTORIC RETURNING CORE

In a league defined by fluctuation and roster volatility, the Greensboro Swarm carried one of the strongest returning cores in the NBA G League this season.

The Swarm retained five players from a season ago, including four of the five most-played players from 2024-25: Jaylen Sims, Keyontae Johnson, Terrell Brown Jr., Marcus Garrett and Isaih Moore, a core that **went on to account for 48.5% of total team minutes a season ago**.

Greensboro's charge was led by Jaylen Sims, a fourth-year player with the Greensboro Swarm who set the franchise's record in scoring a season ago.

**Terrell Brown Jr. and Marcus Garrett**, third-year returners for the Swarm, rank second and third respectively in all-time minutes played for the team at 3,715 and 3,335 minutes, respectively.

Brown Jr. leads the franchise in assists (724) with Garrett leading in steals (167).

Isaih Moore was traded in November for PJ Hall while Keyontae Johnson has his NBA G League contract bought out by the Shandong Ho-Speed Kiring of the Chinese Basketball Association (CBA).

With constant player, movement, the three routinely have subbed in-and-out of the starting unit, but have had zero drop off.

**Brown Jr. became the first player in NBA G League history to record back-to-back triple-doubles off the bench earlier this season, doing so on Dec. 31 and Jan. 3.**

## NBA ASSIGNMENTS SHINE IN GREENSBORO

With the Charlotte Hornets emerging as one of the hottest teams in the NBA, the team has been able to utilize the NBA G League as a development hub to close the season, yielding mutually beneficial results for the organization.

Former No. 6 overall pick Tidjane Salaun played the bulk of the NBA G League Tip-Off Tournament in Greensboro, playing just four regular-season games for the team. With the second-year forward back from injury, the Swarm have utilized him as the key cog for its hopeful Championship run, and he has delivered.

Liam McNeeley, the No. 29 pick in the 2025 NBA Draft, has also found his footing with the Swarm, playing extended reps on the ball in halfcourt situations while carrying a green light from distance. McNeeley set a career mark in the Eastern Conference Finals in 3-pointers made, having drilled four attempts.

On the two-way contract side, all three of PJ Hall, Tosan Evbuomwan and Antonio Reeves have reaped rewards, with Hall garnering All-NBA G League honors and Evbuomwan yet to log minutes in a Hornets uniform, instead all leading the charge in the Swarm's postseason run.

## PJ HALL NAMED TO ALL-NBA G LEAGUE THIRD TEAM

Charlotte Hornets two-way center PJ Hall earned All-NBA G League Third Team honors, becoming the first Swarm player ever named to an All-NBA G League Team. In 23 regular-season games, Hall averaged 18.9 points (.602 FG%, .239 3PT%, .792 FT%), 11.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.7 blocks in 29.6 minutes. He was one of two players to average 18.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and place one 3-pointer and block per game, joining Charles Bassey.

Hall is out for the remainder of the season with a right ankle fracture.

- Picked up hunting while in New Zealand, ate local culinary foods, including kina.
- **His favorite player growing up was Dennis Rodman, the father of Swarm guard DJ Rodman.**

### JONAS AIDOO (00)

- Acquired via the NBA G League Available Player Pool on Dec. 27, 2025.
- Initially joined Swarm as member of its 13-player training camp.
- Most recently played at Arkansas, averaging 6.9 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting a career-best 57% from the field.
- A native of Durham, North Carolina, Aidoo played high school basketball at Durham Voyager Academy and spent a prep year at Liberty Heights Athletic Institute in Charlotte.

### TOSAN EVBUOMWAN (8)\*

- Signed to two-way contract on Feb. 6, 2026, by Charlotte Hornets.
- Carries 50 games of NBA experience entering two-way deal, including five games with the New York Knicks in 2025-26.
- Averaged 9.5 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists across 28 games for the Brooklyn Nets a season ago, playing 23.8 minutes per game in the stint.
- Evbuomwan grew up playing football, rugby, cricket and track & field and was a standout football star, being selected to Newcastle United's Youth Academy.

### EVAN GILYARD II (25)

- NBA G League 2024-25 Community Assist Award Winner
- Represented the G League Intersect Team at the 2025 B.League Global Invitational and the FIBA Intercontinental Cup.
- Carries three seasons of NBA G League experience, totaling 112 appearances (44 starts) prior to joining the Swarm.

### JAIRE GRAYER (0)

- Joined Swarm on Feb. 21, 2026.
- Appeared in 13 games for the team across the 2023-24 and 2024-25 seasons, averaging 5.3 points and 3.3 rebounds in 15.0 minutes per game.
- Most recently played for Santos de San Luis Potosi in the LNBP (Mexico), posting averages of 13.5 points, 6.1 rebounds and 2.5 assists across 29.2 minutes per game.

### CALEB GRILL (2)

- Acquired by the Greensboro Swarm on March 7, 2026, along with a 2027 NBA G League first-round pick (via Windy City) in exchange for center Ibou Badji and a 2026 NBA G League second-round pick (via Greensboro).
- Appeared in 19 regular-season games for the Windy City Bulls in 2025-26, averaging 11.2 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 26.9 minutes per game.
- Knocked down multiple three-pointers in all but four appearances, including a career-high 7-of-13 outing against the Maine Celtics on Feb. 12 (26 points) and 6-of-12 against the Greensboro Swarm on Feb. 2.

### TREVON DUVAL (34)

- Acquired by the Greensboro Swarm from the NBA G League available player pool on March 2026.
- Most recently played for Sabah BC in Azerbaijan during the 2024-25 FIBA Europe Cup, averaging 8.7 points, 2.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists in 25.5 minutes over six games.
- NBA G League veteran with 158 career games, averaging 10.6 points, 2.6 rebounds and 3.9 assists in 23.9 minutes per game; earned a G League Championship with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers in 2018-19.
- A native of Queens, New York, Duval was a McDonald's All-American, played one season at Duke, and had NBA stints with the Milwaukee Bucks and Houston Rockets on two-way contracts; also played professionally in Canada, the Dominican Republic, and Turkey.

**PJ Hall Named to All-NBA G League Third Team (April 7, 2026)** – Charlotte Hornets two-way center PJ Hall earned All-NBA G League Third Team honors, becoming the first Swarm player ever named to an All-NBA G League Team. In 23 regular-season games, Hall averaged 18.9 points (.602 FG%, .239 3PT%, .792 FT%), 11.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.7 blocks in 29.6 minutes. He was one of two players to average 18.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and place one 3-pointer and block per game, joining Charles Bassey.

**Greensboro Swarm Crowned Eastern Conference Champions (April 5, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm earned the Eastern Conference Championship on Sunday, defeating the Osceola Magic wire-to-wire, 134-121. The Swarm led as large as 19 but saw a 40-point effort from Lester Quinones cut the deficit to four in the final seven minutes of play. The Swarm fended this off behind 24 points from Terrell Brown Jr. off the bench.

**Head Coach DJ Bakker, General Manager Cole Teal Finish Top-Three in Season Awards (April 1, 2026)** – Greensboro Swarm Head Coach DJ Bakker and General Manager Cole Teal both finished on the podium for the NBA G League's regular-season awards, with Bakker placing second for Coach of the Year and Teal third for Executive of the Year. The honors follow a 24-12 regular season that secured Greensboro the No. 2 seed in the Eastern Conference, along with a 10-4 mark in the Tip-Off Tournament that earned the franchise its first-ever NBA G League Winter Showcase Tournament appearance. The Swarm were the only team in the league to place top three in both award races.

**Swarm Notch Franchise's First-Ever Playoff Win (March 31, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm collected its first-ever playoff win on Tuesday, defeating the Maine Celtics, 112-90. The Swarm led by as many as 29 points during the game, collecting a wire-to-wire victory with all five starters closing in double-digit scoring.

**Swarm Earn Franchise's First Ever Home Playoff Game (March 26, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm earned its first ever home playoff game, becoming the second team in the Eastern Conference to do so. The Swarm (23-11), punched its ticket after the Wisconsin Herd defeated the Raptors 905.

**Swarm Notches Franchise's Most Wins in a Season (March 13, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm notched its most wins a season ever on Friday, taking down the Osceola Magic for its 32nd win. The mark surpassed 31 wins a season ago, and with five games to spare, the Swarm hold a 32-13 record (71.1%).

**Swarm Clinch Playoff Berth, First in NBA G League to Punch Ticket (March 11, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm became the first player in NBA G League history to earn a playoff berth, defeating the Delaware Blue Coats, 136-116, to earn its second straight postseason berth.

**Swarm Post Third-Largest Win in Franchise History, Handle Blue Coats, 140-98 (March 10, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm defeated the Delaware Blue Coats by 42 points in a 140-98 victory. The team was lifted by a season-high 31 points from Jaylen Sims and a 22-point, 11-rebound double-double from PJ Hall.

**Swarm Acquires Trevon Duval from Available Player Pool (March 9, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm acquired guard Trevon Duval from the NBA G League's available player pool. Duval most recently played for Sabah BC in Azerbaijan during the 2024-25 FIBA Europe Cup, averaging 8.7 points and 4.5 assists over six games. A veteran of 158 NBA G League games, Duval previously won a G League Championship with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers in 2018-19.

**Swarm Acquires Caleb Grill and 2027 First Round Pick, Deals Ibou Badji and 2026 Second-Rounder (March 7, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm acquired guard Caleb Grill and a 2027 NBA G League first-round pick (via Windy City) from the Windy City Bulls in exchange for center Ibou Badji and a 2026 NBA G League second-round pick (via Greensboro). Grill nailed multiple threes in 15-of-19 regular-season games for the Bulls, including three contests of 5+ made threes.

**Swarm Concludes Winning Streak, Ties Franchise Record (March 4, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm saw its eight-winning streak come to a close on Wednesday against the Long Island Nets, dropping, 116-111. The streak tied the franchise's longest-ever at eight games, set during the 2024-25 Tip-Off Tournament.

**Keyontae Johnson's Contract Bought Out by NBA G League (March 4, 2026)** – Forward Keyontae Johnson had his contract buyout by the NBA G League for an overseas opportunity. Johnson, 25, averaged 20.8 points, 5.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists for the Swarm in 21 regular-season games. Across all contests (34 games), he averaged 19.8 points, 4.9 rebounds and 2.7 assists on 52.4/34.1/76.0 splits.

**DJ Bakker Named NBA G League Coach of the Month of February (March 3, 2026)** – Greensboro Swarm Head Coach DJ Bakker earned NBA G League Coach of the Month honors after guiding the Swarm to an 8-1 record in February. All eight victories came by double digits, highlighted by seven straight wins to close the month – the longest regular-season winning streak in franchise history. The surge propelled Greensboro to the top spot in the NBA G League standings.

**Swarm Join Elite Company, Eight-Straight Games With 10+ Points Wins, Tie Franchise Winning Streak (March 1, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm extended their dominant stretch with a 141-105 win over Raptors 905, tying the longest winning streak in franchise history at eight games. All eight victories during the run came by double digits, making Greensboro just the second team in NBA G League history to post eight straight wins of 10 or more points, joining the Canton Charge from Feb. 5-26, 2016. An eight-game streak of double-digit victories has occurred only three times in the NBA since 2020-21, coming from the San Antonio Spurs (8) and Oklahoma City Thunder (9) this season and the Cleveland Cavaliers (10) in 2024-25.

**Swarm Own League's Best Record, Longest Win Streak (Feb. 27, 2026)** – The Greensboro Swarm climbed to the top spot in the NBA G League standings this week with a 17-6 record (.739), while also carrying the league's longest active win streak at six games following an Osceola Magic loss.

**Swarm Join Exclusive Company with Six Straight 10+ Point Wins** – During the stretch, Greensboro became just the 14th team in NBA G League history to record six or more consecutive wins by double digits in a single season (REG + TIP combined). The Swarm were only one of two teams to accomplish the feat this season, joining the Maine Celtics (six games, Nov. 23 – Dec. 10), later surpassing it.

**Swarm Log Franchise's Fewest Made Threes in a Win (Feb. 21, 2026)** – Despite nailing three of 23 attempts (13%) from 3-point range, the Greensboro Swarm routed the Wisconsin Herd, 116-105, in Oshkosh, Wisc. The Swarm's three-made 3-pointers were its fewest ever in a win and its second-fewest made in a game outright. Keyontae Johnson led the charge with 28 points on 10-of-18 shooting, with Evan Gilyard II nailing two threes and Sims converting the third.

**Swarm Add Jaire Grayer (Feb. 21, 2026)** - The Greensboro Swarm added Jaire Grayer to its roster after appearing in 13 games for the team across the 2023-24 and 2024-25 seasons, where he averaged 5.3 points and 3.3 rebounds across 15.0 minutes. He most recently played for Santos de San Luis Potosi in the LNBP (Mexico), where he averaged 13.5 points, 6.1 rebounds and 2.5 assists across 29.2 minutes.

**Ibou Badji Selected to Senegal National Team for World Cup Qualifiers (Feb. 21, 2026)** - Center Ibou Badji was named to Senegal's February 2026 Men's World Cup Qualifying Team as the nation begins Group B play for the 2027 FIBA Basketball World Cup in Qatar. The Dakar native returns to international competition after earning bronze at FIBA AfroBasket 2025 and previously ranking second in blocks (3.1) at the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup. Badji enters action averaging 5.1 points, 4.9 rebounds and 2.5 blocks in 27 G League appearances this season, as Senegal hosts Côte d'Ivoire (Feb. 26), Madagascar (Feb. 28) and DR Congo (March 1) in Dakar.

**Swarm Celebrate Legacy Night, Honor 10 Seasons in Greensboro (Feb. 12, 2026)** - The Greensboro Swarm welcomed back former players Damien Wilkins (franchise's first scorer), Shonn Miller (franchise's first draft pick) and Sam Thompson (92 appearances) alongside multiple former front-office members against the Capital City Go-Go for Legacy Night. The event highlighted the Swarm's 10 seasons in Greensboro, showcasing the team's history, appearance and successes.

**Swarm Acquire Evan Gilyard II, Rights to Armando Bacot, Deal Dixon (Feb. 10, 2026)** - The Greensboro Swarm acquired guard Evan Gilyard II and the returning player rights to Armando Bacot from the Memphis Hustle in exchange for forward Eric Dixon. Gilyard II, the 2024-25 NBA G League Community Assist Award Winner, joined the Swarm with 112 NBA G League games under his belt, averaging 10.1 points, 1.6 rebounds and 3.7 assists for the Hustle across 29 games (15 starts). Bacot is currently playing for Fenerbahçe Beko of the Basketbol Süper Ligi and the EuroLeague, while Dixon averaged 11.0 points, 3.2 rebounds and 0.9 assists across 27 games (four starts) in Greensboro.

**Charlotte Hornets Ink Tosan Evbuomwan to Two-Way Contract (Feb. 6, 2026)** - The Charlotte Hornets signed forward Tosan Evbuomwan to a two-way deal. A native of Newcastle upon Tyne, England, Evbuomwan joined the Hornets with 50 games of NBA experience (eight starts) across three seasons between Brooklyn, Detroit, Memphis and New York. Evbuomwan holds career averages of 7.4 points, 3.6 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 20.8 minutes per game. In a related move, the team waived guard KJ Simpson.

**Swarm Fall Short Despite Historic First Quarter (Feb. 6, 2026)** - The Swarm logged a 46-point opening quarter against the Cleveland Charge, going 17-of-25 (68%) during the stint and adding three threes and nine points at the line. It tied the Swarm's second-most points in a quarter, trailing a 47-point opener on March 26, 2022, and a 46-point fourth quarter on Dec. 18, 2017. Cleveland won the contest, 140-135.

**Swarm Logs 90 Points in the Paint Against Bulls (Feb. 2, 2026)** - Postponed from a Jan. 31 date due to weather, the Swarm poured in 90 points in the paint versus the Windy City Bulls to charge a 23-point, 126-103 victory. The 90-point effort ranked just outside of the NBA G League's 20-Top list in the category, with the accolade last notched in 2023 in NBA ranks.

**Swarm Posts Historic Opener Against Maine Celtics (Jan. 25, 2026)** - The Swarm etched the record books against the Maine Celtics, posting the franchise's best field goal % in a quarter, a 20-of-23 (86.9%) output, and converting on its first 20 two-point shots. The 20-consecutive makes marked the most two-pointers made in a row to start a game in NBA G League history (previously a mark of 13) and was the second-longest streak in league history. Despite the historic start, the Celtics clawed back for the victory.

**DJ Bakker Logs 50th Win as Swarm Head Coach (Jan. 19, 2026)** - Head Coach DJ Bakker notched his 50th win with the Swarm against the Birmingham Squadron.

**Jaylen Sims Eclipses 2,500 Swarm Points (Jan. 10, 2026)** - Guard Jaylen Sims reached 2,500 career points with the Swarm against the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, chiming in 17 points in the effort. Sims, the franchise's all-time leading scorer -- is one of 13 players in NBA G League history to log the accolade with one team.

**Swarm Set Franchise Scoring Record, Second Time in 2025-26 (Jan. 5, 2026)** - The Swarm pitched in a franchise-best 149 points in its 149-119 victory over the Grand Rapids Gold on Jan. 5. It bested its 145-point effort against the Delaware Blue Coats during the NBA G League Tip-Off Tournament, which stood as a franchise record at the time.

**Keyontae Johnson Goes For 40 Points (Jan. 5, 2026)** - Forward Keyontae Johnson led the way for the Swarm during its record-setting scoring output, pouring on 40 points on 14-of-18 shooting (5-of-5 from 3PT) while adding seven assists. It was the ninth-highest scoring effort in franchise history, the third-highest in a win, and tied the franchise record for most threes in a game without a miss. He followed it up with a 30-point showing against the Rio Grande Valley Vipers on Jan. 9.

**Swarm Posts Longest Regular-Season Winning Streak in Franchise History (Jan. 5, 2026)** - The Greensboro Swarm moved atop the NBA G League standings following its 149-119 win over the Grand Rapids Gold, moving to 6-1 while setting a franchise record for most consecutive wins during the regular season at six. The Swarm fell to open the regular season, dropping to the Grand Rapids Gold in the opening round of the NBA League Winter Showcase Tournament, however it rattled off six-straight wins, beginning against the San Diego Clippers on Dec. 21.

**Terrell Brown Jr.'s Triple-Double Makes NBA G League History (Jan. 3, 2026)** - Guard Terrell Brown Jr. became the first player in NBA G League history to post triple-doubles off the bench in back-to-back games -- logging 19 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high 15 assists against the Grand Rapids Gold. He opened the effort on Dec. 31, marking 11 points, 10 rebounds and 13 assists against the Texas Legends.

**PJ Hall Notches NBA Call-Up with Charlotte Hornets (Dec. 24, 2025)** - Center PJ Hall earned the 17th NBA Call-Up of the season, joining the Hornets on a two-way contract after spending 11 games with the Swarm, where he averaged 13.7 points, 9.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.5 blocks across 27.2 minutes per game. Drew Peterson was waived in a subsequent move.

**Keyontae Johnson Reaches 1,000 Swarm Points (Dec. 19, 2025)** - Keyontae Johnson surpassed 1,000 points for the Swarm against the Gold, averaging 18.2 points, 4.4 rebounds and 2.5 assists at the closure of play.

**Swarm Fall in First Round of Winter Showcase Tournament (Dec. 19, 2025)** - The Greensboro Swarm slipped to the Grand Rapids Gold to open its first-ever NBA G League Winter Showcase Tournament appearance, slipping, 119-106. Antonio Reeves led the way for the Swarm with 17 points, while Moses Brown paced the Gold with 27 points and 11 rebounds in 24 minutes.

Teal enters his fifth season with the Greensboro Swarm and his third as General Manager, after previously serving as Manager of Basketball Operations & Player Development and as a Basketball Operations Assistant with the franchise.

Across his first two seasons as General Manager, Teal guided the Swarm to steady improvement, culminating in the franchise's first playoff berth during the 2024–25 season. Greensboro posted a 20–14 regular-season record to finish fourth in the conference and an overall mark of 31–19, tied for the fourth-best record in the NBA G League, including an 11–5 showing during the Showcase Cup. Despite limited availability from Hornets assignees, the Swarm's success was driven largely by affiliate players and G League contract additions.

Building through affiliate players and G League contracts, the 2024–25 Swarm roster featured former NBA G League champions Keyontae Johnson and Caleb McConnell (Oklahoma City Blue, 2023–24), while retaining core contributors Jaylen Sims, Marcus Garrett, M.J. Walker and Terrell Brown Jr. The team also made a notable in-season addition in forward Reggie Perry from the Osceola Magic.

The season matched the largest single-season win improvement in franchise history and represented the second-largest improvement across the league. Individually, Sims became the franchise's all-time leading scorer on Feb. 21, 2025, against the Mexico City Capitanes.

Teal joined the Swarm after serving as a Basketball Operations Associate with the Delaware Blue Coats and the Windy City Bulls. During his time in Delaware, he contributed to the development of Haywood Highsmith, supporting his growth from a local tryout participant into an NBA rotation player. With Windy City, Teal was part of a basketball operations group that helped support player development pathways leading to NBA opportunities, including guard Max Strus. Additional players Teal has worked with during his career who have gone on to NBA roles include Daniel Gafford, Jarred Vanderbilt, Mark Williams and Shake Milton.

Players Teal has worked with have also gone on to success internationally, including Jaron Blossomgame, Milton Doyle, P.J. Dozier and Keenan Evans. Windy City alumnus Adam Mokoka has represented France in FIBA competition, while former Swarm guard Théo Maledon has reestablished himself as one of Europe's top point guards, earning All-EuroLeague Second Team honors with ASVEL before signing with Real Madrid.

A graduate of Williams College, Teal earned a bachelor's degree in psychology and was a four-year member of the men's basketball program, starting on the 2017 NCAA Division III Final Four team. He has also served as support staff for USA Basketball at the Junior National Team, AmeriCup, World Cup Qualifier, and World Cup levels. Teal began his professional career with internships at Fenway Sports Management and the Houston Rockets.





**DJ BAKKER**  
HEAD COACH  
Second Season with Swarm



DJ Bakker is set to return to the helm for his second season as head coach of the Greensboro Swarm while serving as an assistant coach under Charles Lee for the Charlotte Hornets.

In his debut season in Greensboro, Bakker transformed the Swarm into a contender, guiding the team to a 20-14 regular-season record and its first-ever playoff berth.

The team's momentum started before the regular season with a dominant run in the Tip-Off Tournament, where it strung together eight straight wins and finished 11-5. The effort rolled into the season, winning five of its opening six contests, and after opening 8-7, winning nine of its next 11 games to position itself for postseason play.

Bakker, the fourth head coach in franchise history, is a decorated veteran with 11 years of NBA coaching experience. Prior to his time in Greensboro, Bakker most recently served as an assistant coach for the Milwaukee Bucks (2023-24).

He spent five seasons (2018-23) with the Detroit Pistons, beginning as a player development coach before being promoted to an assistant coach. He served as the head coach of the Motor City Cruise, Detroit's NBA G League affiliate, beginning in their inaugural 2021-22 season, accumulating a 39-25 (.609) record over two years.

Bakker's NBA coaching experience includes player development roles with the Dallas Mavericks (2015-16) and Toronto Raptors (2016-18). During his time in Toronto, Bakker worked on development programs for Pascal Siakam, Fred VanVleet and Norman Powell.

Bakker spent one season (2013-14) as a regional advance scout for the Orlando Magic, and he began his NBA career in 2009-10 as a video coordinator with the Chicago Bulls. In addition to his NBA experience, Bakker also worked as a player development coach for three years under renowned trainer Tim Grover at ATTACK Athletics in Chicago.

A native of Highland, Indiana, Bakker played basketball at Trinity Christian College, where he earned a degree in business administration. He and his wife, Laura, have three children – Chasity, Kinsley and Benson.

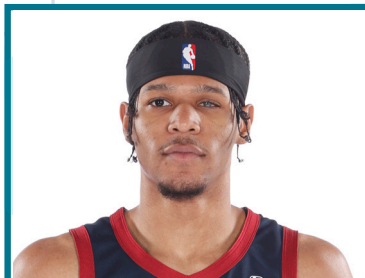
