WHAT'S THE BUZZ?

DOSE OF DOUBLE DIGITS

The Greensboro Swarm and Westchester Knicks have carried scoring options throughout their respective rotations, with both being two of five teams to carry 10 players averaging 10+ PPG entering the two-game series.

With assignments and two-way scorers in the fold, the Swarm's "everybody eats" playstyle has stood the test of the transaction log, as nine of its 10 players have played in at least five games. Only the Stars carry greater with 10.

The Knicks' figure drops to four under these restrictions, the biggest plummet in the league and the second-fewest of all teams, tied for 28th.

GLASS CLEANERS

The Greensboro Swarm entered its two-game set against the Westchester Knicks leading the NBA G League in rebounds per game (51.1), being the lone to rank in the top three in offensive and defensive rebounds.

After Friday's conclusion, it now ranks fourth leaguewide.

Josiah Allick has led the way on the offensive glass, placing fourth league-wide in OREB% (18.0%), behind seasoned bigs Moses Brown, Oscar Tshiebwe and Knicks big Vinicius Da Silva, who was traded from the Oklahoma City Blue during the NBA G League Draft.

SHINING AFTER ASSIGNMENT

Second-year forward **Tidjane Salaun** netted strong reps with the Swarm through 10 contests, posting averages of 16.6 points and 7.8 rebounds while shooting 47.8% from the field and 37.0% from distance.

In the team's set against the Long Island Nets, he led the way averaging 24.0 points, 6 rebounds and 1.5 assists, with his latter effort being a 25-point effort on 10-of-18 shooting. The baseball-set opener saw him convert on 6-of-7 free throws.

He logged a 26-point (9-of-13 FG), nine rebound and five assist effort on Nov. 13 against the Delaware Blue Coats and a game-winning 3-point shot vs. the Maine Celtics, 122-120, on Nov. 8.

He was recalled to the Hornets on Nov. 30, averaging 14.7 points, 3.7 rebounds and 0.3 assists on .636/.643/.778 splits in three games back with Charlotte.

HALLMARK

Center **PJ Hall** has carried strong efforts with the Greensboro Swarm since beginning his tenure with the team on Nov. 20.

Waived by the Memphis Grizzlies days prior and acquired from Mexico City in the G League waiver pool, the Swarm brought in the 6-foot-8 big in exchange for Isaih Moore and an international pick next season.

After getting in early foul trouble in his Swarm debut, PJ Hall has placed double-doubles with points in rebounds in four of his past five games, averaging 12.2 points and 9.7 rebounds with the team thus far.

A Summer League Champion with the Charlotte Hornets, Hall has displayed the ability to play around the interior or navigate inside the paint, emphasized in the Swarm's previous contest, in which he posted two thunderous dunks in the first quarter.

TIP-OFF TALLY

The Swarm are midway through its Tip-Off Tournament slate, trailing the unbeaten Raptors 905 (10-0) in the East Division.

With the top eight teams notching a seed in the Winter Showcase's Tournament, the Swarm are currently the first team outside of tournament action at 7-4, good for 9th in the league. Albeit, multiple teams in the top eight trail in games played.

TWO-WAY TESTS

The Charlotte Hornets and Greensboro Swarm have been one of the league's most active in transfers and assignments this season.

Through 10 games, all three Hornets two-way players have seen court time, Reeves (five games), KJ Simpson (four games) and Drew Peterson (seven games).

Tidjane Salaun has played in 10 contests for the Swarm this season.

Swarm Build Lead, Hold Off Late Rally to Defeat Knicks, 112-106

GREENSBORO, NC – The Greensboro Swarm (7-4) held strong on Friday night at Novant Health Fieldhouse, securing a 112-106 victory over the Westchester Knicks (1-9).

In a game defined by momentum swings, the Swarm built a lead as large as 28 points – powered by a decisive 21-4 run – before withstanding a late push that saw Westchester erase the deficit and briefly take the lead in the final period. Greensboro responded with poise, delivering eight unanswered points down the stretch to reclaim control and close out the win.

Jaylen Sims paced the Swarm with 26 points, while Drew Peterson followed with 25 points on an efficient 11-of-17 shooting (3-of-6 3PT). PJ Hall recorded his third consecutive double-double, finishing with 20 points and 11 rebounds on 8-of-13 shooting.

Dink Pate and Kevin McCullar Jr. led Westchester with 21 points apiece.

Westchester opened the night with early momentum, racing to an 8-0 lead in the first 90 seconds behind a perfect 3-of-3 start and a pair of defensive stops. Greensboro countered with an 11-3 run, highlighted by a one-handed cockback dunk from Hall following a pump fake on the left wing. The Swarm continued to press forward, taking a 32-25 lead through the first quarter behind 10 early points from Sims.

Greensboro pushed the margin to double digits midway through the second quarter, fueled by 3-pointers from Hall and Eric Dixon. The run stretched to 21-4 as the Swarm took command, ultimately entering halftime with a 68-45 advantage.

Greensboro's first-half production was balanced across all three levels, connecting on 8-of-18 shots from beyond the arc, converting all six free-throw attempts, and holding the Knicks to just three made threes. Hall and Sims both posted 16 first-half points, with Hall going a perfect 6-of-6 from the field.

Westchester battled back in the third quarter, closing on a 24-11 run to trim the deficit to 93-78 entering the fourth. The Knicks carried their momentum into the final period, opening on a 13-2 push to bring the margin to 95-91.

Westchester reclaimed its first lead since the first quarter at the 4:13 mark, briefly taking a 103-100 lead before the Swarm regained their footing with eight straight points to retake the advantage for good.

Game Notes:

- Jaylen Sims and Drew Peterson both notched season highs in scoring with 26 and 25 points, respectively. It marked the ninth time in franchise history that two players logged 25+ points in a game.
- The Swarm posted its largest lead in a home contest this season, going up as large as 28 points in play.
- PJ Hall marked his most points as a member of the Swarm on Friday with 20 points. He went a perfect 6-of-6 for 16 points in the first half.
- The Swarm tallied three or more 20+ point scorers in the contest (PJ Hall, Jaylen Sims, Drew Peterson) for the first time since Nov. 22, 2025, against the Long Island Nets – the 52nd time in franchise history.
- Brandon Slater fouled out in 12:29, the second-quickest foul out in franchise history. Jeremiah Tillmon fouled out in 12:06 minutes against the Long Island Nets on Nov. 11, 2023.
- Josiah Allick finished Friday's game with five offensive rebounds in just 12:26 of total playing time — the second-fewest minutes in a complete game for any Swarm player with 5+ offensive boards. The only Swarm performance with fewer total minutes was Demajeo Wiggins' seven offensive rebounds in 11:21 against Westchester on Nov. 13, 2019. Allick ranks fourth in the league in OREB% (18.0).

BREAKING DOWN THE RANKINGS

For the Tip-Off Tournament, teams are placed into four regions to play 14 games exclusively against each other. The teams with the best winning percentage in each region, along with the next four teams with the best winning percentages regardless of region, will advance to compete for the Championship at the NBA G League Winter Showcase. Every team will play at least two games at the Winter Showcase.
