



GREENSBORO SWARM OPEN PLAYER TRYOUTS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Who can try out?

A: Any participant age 18 or older (on the day of the tryout), as long as either (i) you have graduated high school, or (ii) the class you would have graduated with has graduated.

Q: Are there any costs?

A: Yes, participating players are asked to complete an application and pay a \$260 non-refundable application fee plus fees until August 31 and \$300 starting September 1. Interested participants may register online at:

Q: Can I pay with a credit card?

A: Yes, you may use a credit card to pre-register.

Q: What does my registration fee include?

A: The registration fee includes an opportunity to try out in front of Greensboro Swarm basketball operations personnel. Also included is a Greensboro Swarm tryout jersey. Q: How can I sign up? A: Register online

Q: Can I register on the day of tryouts?

A: Yes, but space is limited to the first 125 participants. Early registration is highly encouraged. Participants who register past August 31 or on the day-of or will be charged \$300, payable in cash or with credit card on-site. Please note that if you are paying with a CC then you will be charged tax + fees.

Q: Where will the tryout be held?

A: The tryouts will be held on Saturday, September 19 at the UNCG Kaplan Center for Wellness: 1301 W Gate City Blvd, Greensboro, NC 27403.

Q: What time will the tryout begin?

A: Registration begins at 9 a.m. with the tryout starting at 10:30 a.m.

Q: Parking:

A: Parking is free in the lot in front of the complex; however, it is limited.

Q: Will there be professional basketball scouts there?

A: Yes, representatives from the Greensboro Swarm and Charlotte Hornets basketball operations departments will be present.

Q: Are spectators allowed to come watch participants tryout?

A: Participants are welcome to invite friends and family to watch; however, due to limited space in the gym, we kindly ask that guests be kept to a minimum.

Q: When will I find out if I have been invited to training camp?

A: The Greensboro Swarm basketball operations staff will notify those players who are selected to attend Greensboro Swarm training camp.

Q: Will food be provided?

A: No food will be provided.

Q: Will there be access to locker rooms?

A: There will not be any on-site lockers available for storage – please do not bring valuables.

Q: What can I bring to the facility? Do I need to bring my own towel, water, etc?

A: Water fountains will be available in the facility. Please bring anything else you need (i.e. towels, ankle braces, socks, energy bars) as no other equipment, food or beverages will be provided.

Q: Do I need an agent to participate?

A: No, you do not.

Q: What happens if I sign up and cannot attend? Will my money be refunded?

A: Absolutely no refunds will be given under any circumstances due to limited availability for participation in the tryout.

Q: Will I be reimbursed for any travel costs?

A: No, all participants must cover any travel, lodging and transportation costs.

Q: What do I need to bring to check-in? Do I need a valid ID?

A: Yes, you must have a valid government-issued photo ID to check-in as well as your completed registration form(s) if you do not pre-register.

Q: Do I need to sign a waiver?
